Pledge of Allegiance

Minutes Read: Joseph Rish made a motion to accept the minutes, Michael Waslin seconded. All in favor.

Treasurer's Report: *Report read. Amy Yuhas made a motion to accept, Michael Waslin seconded. All in favor. Debra Youngblood made a motion to pay bills, Jeff Ford seconded. All in favor.

Old Business: *Tom will be applying for a LSA Grant for a Police Cruiser but it has to be separate. Aaron Kauffer is pushing for regionalization. Each grant will have a \$100 application fee.
*Carl would like the parking lot paved with grant money. Scott recommends taking care of the sub base in the lot, then pave completely with future grant money. HRG fee for the parking lot will be \$6,000.
Jill needs the signed WWSA paperwork to get to Scott for the MS4 report.
*Ron Moreck's home is posted. The second floor caved in on the first. This may be another home to demo because it's a health hazard.
*220 Cooper St.- Jason met with the homeowners and gave them 30 days to clean up.
Bryden Ct. home was sold to John Dennis, but it will be demolished and a permit was already issued for the work.
*Jill asked what we will be doing to hire crossing guards. Carl aid, "Mark will be covering as a crossing guard until we can find someone." The Mayor does not think a guard is needed on the Terrance. Jill will get copies of the school calendar to the guards.

*Water lines on Cooper were worked on, they should be paved curb to curb.

September meeting will be moved to Tuesday Sept 27th due to Jill being on vacation. Amy Yuhas made the motion to change the date, Tom Vest seconded.

Jill will advertise the RFP again for engineering services so council can hire at the next meeting.

Paving bids will be postponed until December due to the high prices of the current bids received.

New Business:

*Jill asked Council if Resolutions should be added to the Website, based on what Jill is seeing most do not have theirs listed. Council decided to have them uploaded.

*We have a \$140,000 Cd maturing. Amy Yuhas made a motion to purchase a 2yr at 3.35%, Jeff Ford seconded. All in favor.

*Solar panel speed signs will be placed before school starts. Amy looked into a grant to have these paid from, unfortunately there was nothing. Carl will reach out to Aarons office to discuss, both Tom and Carl recall being told there was a grant available. Jill will be paying from the American Rescue Act funds.

*John Piesala recommend promoting Greg Jr to Sargent with no increase in pay. In turn Greg Jr. will be able to attend seminars in Harrisburg and will be able to do payroll. Joe Rish made the motion to promote Jr., Debra Youngblood seconded.

*Ammunition cost is be appropriately \$900.00 Tom Vest made a motion to pay, Michael Waslin seconded. All in favor .

*Jill explained to council the difficulties of paying and keeping track of the advertising/engineering fees for all the different grants we have.
