Carl updated the council on the status of the 309 Bridge removal project. The moving of the sewer lines that goes along with the project will be included in the budget for the project. And the street light that is being added as a part of the project will have to be maintained by Courtdale Borough, as well as the cost of maintenance, and insurance.

The meeting that was held with the street department the day after the January meeting, regarding plowing and scheduling was a very successful meeting. Issues are resolved
