Treasurer's Report: \*Report read. Joseph Rish made a motion to accept, Jeffrey Ford seconded. All in favor. Debra Youngblood made a motion to pay bills, Joseph Rish seconded. All in favor.

Committees: \*Carl said, "We met with the new hire Shawn for the street department and hired him. He's been a big help."

Old Business: \*Larksville Fire Dept requested a meeting, as discussed last month. Debbie and Joe are both available next week, Tues. Wed. or Thurs. Carl will reach out to Tony Yuscavage to attend as well. Greg will run a 911 report of calls.

\*The Crossing Guard Bear Creek school issue has been rectified. The mom is ok with not having anyone cross the kids in the a.m. Mr. Matello has been complaining to Greg that Terry Wildoner does not have a reflective vest. Council approved Mark to purchase 2 from Bassler. Mark will ask Russ if Shirley can return hers.

\*Carl is asking council for permission to replace the mirror at Albert Street. Jacki does not think it works anyway, "it's too small to see traffic." Jeff Ford made a motion to purchase, Debra Youngblood seconded.

\*Decal on the truck has not been applied yet, but will say "Street Department".

\*Zomerfeld has not replied to the lawsuit and the Insurance Co. confirmed they cannot settle without councils' consent.

\*Street Dept salaries were tabled last meeting. Jeff spoke up and said, he is for it. Jill said the Street Dept. is currently at \$12.87 and \$13.39. Carl reminded council they will get a raise in January. Jeff

made a motion to pay \$15.00 and \$14.50 to the Street Dept. employees. A roll call vote was taken. All in favor. The pay raise will start with the next payroll (October 16<sup>th</sup>-31<sup>st</sup>)  
\*Santa letter from Fire Co. has not been received.  
\*Carl will reach out to WWSA to see if they will camera the line on Bryden Ct., it keeps settling and the Water Co. detected a leak.

New Business:

\*Tom Vest called Jill to get a resolute drawn up for the Multimodal Grant due November 14<sup>th</sup>. Tom will work on but asked that someone takes it over. Carl volunteered. The amount is the same but requires matching funds \$2,311,400.00.  
\*Carl also mentioned the ARPA grant that was due October 27<sup>th</sup>, Joe and Tom worked on one from the county for the park, but this was different. Carl does not think we have ever done a DCER grant. Carl will forward the information to Joe.  
\*Michael Waslin made the motion the pass the Multimodal Resolution, Joseph Rish seconded. A roll call vote was taken. All in favor.  
\*Jill read Tom Vest's resignation letter. Jeff Ford made a motion to accept the resignation letter. Debra Youngblood seconded.  
\*Jill spoke to Karen Butler in Pringle who gets paid an hourly rate of \$15.50 per hour. Carl and council agreed to reach out to see if Karen's interested in taking over the grant work.  
\*The budget will need to be read at next months meeting.  
\*Council discussed the Election for next year and Len looked into who will be running: For Tom's seat council will appoint someone and they will fill the remainder of his term. After much discussion it was determined that 2023 Election will be:
