TREASURER'S REPORT:

COMMITTEES:

OLD BUSINESS:

American Asphalt update—payment has been received from the balance of the grant due to American Asphalt. Checks have been issued to American Asphalt and all debt with American Asphalt has been satisfied and the grant has been closed.

NEW BUSINESS:

The Reorganization meeting will be held Monday January 5th around 6 or 7 contingent on Judge Barilla's schedule to swear in the members for their new terms(Joe Rish, Joe Biniek,Amy Yuhas,Jeff Ford and Mayor Degnan). The regular monthly meetings will continue to be held on the third Tuesday of each month. The dates will be published by the end of the year.

Mayor Degnan will be working on applying for an LSA grant for the fence/wall at the park and Carl would like to include a salt shed for the storage of the winter road salt stores as well as the equipment for the street department.

Loriann was inquiring about the Little League field /organization. WVSA sends a bill for stormwater fees to the borough building address but the borough is not the land owner—Loriann is trying to determine who the bill should be sent to. We will reach out to Mike Lehman who was the president of the organization at last known time.

Secretary will be off November 1-8.

Amy motioned to pay the tax collector \$13.75, check # 5268 with Jeff seconding the motion, all were in favor.

Carl received a pave cut request that involves East Hill street—the means of the request includes repaving the area of the street curb to curb which means this street can be removed from the list of streets submitted as part of the grant money received for repaving multiple roads in Courtdale.

Mark Romanoski let it be known that he prefers not to be called out for plowing emergencies from 911,Shawn said he would do if need be.

Amy motioned to adjourn the meeting at 7:39pm with Debbie seconding the motion, all were in favor to adjourn.
