

**A RESOLUTION OF THE BOROUGH OF COURTDALE SETTING FORTH  
RULES AND REGULATIONS FOR THE USE OF PENNSYLVANIA'S  
COOPERATIVE PURCHASING PROGRAM**

**WHEREAS**, the Pennsylvania Procurement Code authorizes a municipality to participate in Pennsylvania's Cooperative Purchasing Program (COSTARS) for the procurement of supplies, services or construction from registered local suppliers and state affiliated members in accordance with an agreement entered into between the participants.

**WHEREAS**, the Council of the Borough of Courtdale seeks to utilize efficient and cost-effective procurement practices for the benefit of its residents and taxpayers; and

**WHEREAS**, it is the desire and intent of the Council for the Borough of Courtdale to set forth rules and regulations to ensure the Borough's cooperative purchasing partners are registered members of the Pennsylvania Cooperative Purchasing Program (COSTARS).

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED:**

**THAT**, Council for the Borough of Courtdale hereby requires, prior to entering into any procurement contract, written certification from the Borough Engineer and Borough Solicitor that a prospective purchasing partner is indeed an active, registered member of the COSTARS program; and

**THAT**, this Resolution shall be effective immediately upon passage.
